
Notice



Employees are encouraged to be interactive and communicative with their co-workers and with those outside the company. 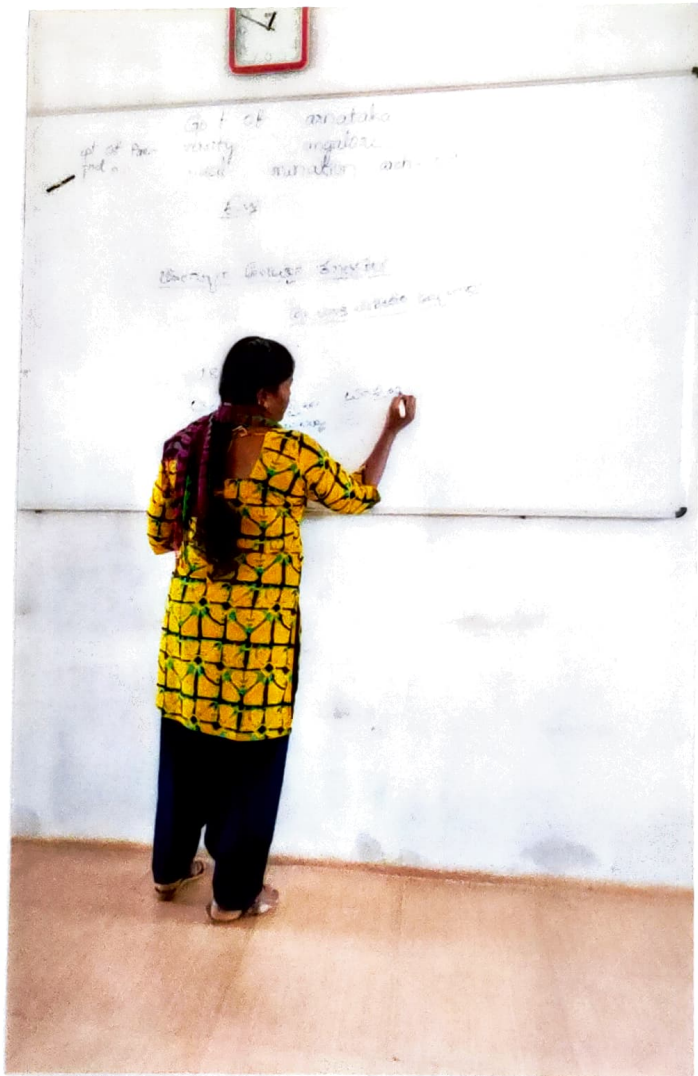
